

1 INTRODUCTION TO THE REVELATION OF CHRIST AS THE AMAZING SERVANT

MATTHEW 1:1

"The record of the genealogy of Jesus the Messiah, the son of David, the son of Abraham"

MATTHEW 28:19-20

"Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, ²⁰teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

MARK 16:20
