LESSON ONE: WHAT GOD RECOGNIZES AS PRAYER

<u>LUKE 11:1</u> "It happened that while Jesus was praying in a certain place, after He had finished, one of His disciples said to Him, "LORD, TEACH US TO PRAY"

1 THESSALONIANS 5:17 "PRAY WITHOUT CEASING"

<u>PHILIPPIANS 4:6</u> 'Be anxious for nothing, but IN EVERYTHING BY PRAYER AND SUPPLICATION WITH THANKSGIVING LET YOUR REQUESTS BE MADE KNOWN TO GOD.'

PHILIPPIANS 1:3 'I THANK MY GOD IN ALL MY REMEMBRANCE OF YOU, ALWAYS OFFERING PRAYER WITH JOY IN MY EVERY PRAYER FOR YOU ALL'

PSALM 32:6 "Therefore, LET EVERYONE WHO IS GODLY PRAY TO YOU in a time when You may be found"

<u>ROMANS 8:26-27</u> "In the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the spirit himself intercedes for *us* with groanings too deep for words; and he who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the spirit is, because he intercedes for the saints according to *the will of* God."
