MATTHEW 26:41 "KEEP WATCHING AND PRAYING THAT YOU MAY NOT ENTER INTO TEMPTATION; THE SPIRIT IS WILLING, BUT THE FLESH IS WEAK."

<u>HEBREWS 2:16-18</u> "For assuredly He does not give help to angels, but He gives help to the descendant of Abraham. Therefore, He had to be made like His brethren in all things, so that He might become a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people. For SINCE HE HIMSELF WAS TEMPTED IN THAT WHICH HE HAS SUFFERED, HE IS ABLE TO COME TO THE AID OF THOSE WHO ARE TEMPTED."

<u>JOHN 13:16</u> "Truly, truly, I say to you, A SLAVE IS NOT GREATER THAN HIS MASTER, nor *is* one who is sent greater than the one who sent him."

HEBREWS 12:2 "fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, WHO FOR THE JOY SET BEFORE HIM ENDURED THE CROSS, DESPISING THE SHAME..."

<u>GALATIANS 4:6-7</u> "Because you are sons, GOD HAS SENT FORTH THE SPIRIT OF HIS SON INTO OUR HEARTS, CRYING, "ABBA! FATHER!" Therefore you are no longer a slave, but a son; and if a son, then an heir through God."

<u>ROMANS 8:15</u> "For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but YOU HAVE RECEIVED A SPIRIT OF ADOPTION AS SONS BY WHICH WE CRY OUT, "ABBA! FATHER!"

MARK 14:36 "And He was saying, "Abba! Father! All things are possible for You; REMOVE THIS CUP FROM ME; yet not what I will, but what You will."

<u>MATTHEW 26:42</u> "He went away again a second time and prayed, saying, "My Father, if this cannot pass away unless I drink it, YOUR WILL BE DONE."

<u>LUKE 22:42</u> "He knelt down and *began* to pray, saying, "Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me; yet NOT MY WILL, BUT YOURS BE DONE."

LUKE 22:43 "NOW AN ANGEL FROM HEAVEN APPEARED TO HIM, STRENGTHENING HIM."

MATTHEW 26:46 "GET UP, LET US BE GOING; behold, the one who betrays Me is at hand!"

ROMANS 8:26-27 "In the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for WE DO NOT KNOW HOW TO PRAY as we should, BUT THE SPIRIT HIMSELF INTERCEDES FOR *US* with groanings too deep for words; and He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because HE INTERCEDES FOR THE SAINTS ACCORDING TO *THE WILL OF GOD.*"
