

THE EXCHANGED LIFE: THE SLAVE'S APRON

JOHN 13:1 Now before the Feast of the Passover, Jesus knowing that His hour had come that He would depart out of this world to the Father, **HAVING LOVED HIS OWN WHO WERE IN THE WORLD**, He loved them to the end.

JOHN 10:10 I CAME THAT THEY MAY HAVE LIFE, AND HAVE IT ABUNDANTLY.

PHILIPPIANS 2:9-11 FOR THIS REASON ALSO, GOD HIGHLY EXALTED HIM, AND BESTOWED ON HIM THE NAME WHICH IS ABOVE EVERY NAME, SO THAT AT THE NAME OF JESUS EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, OF THOSE WHO ARE IN HEAVEN AND ON EARTH AND UNDER THE EARTH, AND THAT EVERY TONGUE WILL CONFESS THAT JESUS CHRIST IS LORD, TO THE GLORY OF GOD THE FATHER.

PHILIPPIANS 2:5-8 Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

PHILIPPIANS 2:6-7 Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men.

PHILIPPIANS 2:6(b) DID NOT REGARD EQUALITY WITH GOD A THING TO BE GRASPED

HEBREWS 2:14 THEREFORE, SINCE THE CHILDREN SHARE IN FLESH AND BLOOD, HE HIMSELF LIKEWISE ALSO PARTOOK OF THE SAME, THAT THROUGH DEATH HE MIGHT RENDER POWERLESS HIM WHO HAD THE POWER OF DEATH, THAT IS, THE DEVIL

PHILIPPIANS 2:8 Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by **BECOMING OBEDIENT TO THE POINT OF DEATH, EVEN DEATH ON A CROSS.**

ROMANS 7:18 For I know that nothing good dwells **IN ME**, that is, in my flesh

ROMANS 5:10 For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, **MUCH MORE, HAVING BEEN RECONCILED, WE SHALL BE SAVED BY HIS LIFE.**

JOHN 6:38 FOR I HAVE COME DOWN FROM HEAVEN, NOT TO DO MY OWN WILL, BUT THE WILL OF HIM WHO SENT ME.

JOHN 8:42 "If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and have come from God, for I HAVE NOT EVEN COME ON MY OWN INITIATIVE, BUT HE SENT ME.

LUKE 19:10 FOR THE SON OF MAN HAS COME TO SEEK AND TO SAVE THAT WHICH WAS LOST."

JOHN 1:14 AND THE WORD BECAME FLESH, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

JOHN 19:30 He said, "IT IS FINISHED!" And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.

JOHN 14:12 Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do, he will do also; and **GREATER WORKS THAN THESE HE WILL DO; BECAUSE I GO TO THE FATHER.**

2 CORINTHIANS 5:20 THEREFORE, WE ARE AMBASSADORS FOR CHRIST, AS THOUGH GOD WERE ENTREATING THROUGH US;; WE BEG YOU ON BEHALF OF CHRIST, BE RECONCILED TO GOD

JOHN 20:21-22 So Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you; AS THE FATHER HAS SENT ME, I ALSO SEND YOU." AND WHEN HE HAD SAID THIS, HE BREATHED ON THEM AND SAID TO THEM, "RECEIVE THE HOLY SPIRIT

ISAIAH 55:8-9 "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," declares the Lord. "FOR AS THE HEAVENS ARE HIGHER THAN THE EARTH, SO ARE MY WAYS HIGHER THAN YOUR WAYS AND MY THOUGHTS THAN YOUR THOUGHTS.

I CORINTHIANS 1:21 For since IN THE WISDOM OF GOD THE WORLD THROUGH ITS WISDOM DID NOT COME TO KNOW GOD, God was well-pleased through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe.

ISAIAH 55:9 "FOR AS THE HEAVENS ARE HIGHER THAN THE EARTH, SO ARE MY WAYS HIGHER THAN YOUR WAYS AND MY THOUGHTS THAN YOUR THOUGHTS

1 CORINTHIANS 2:9-10 "Things which eye has not seen and ear has not heard, And which have not entered the heart of man, All that God has prepared for those who love Him." FOR TO US GOD REVEALED THEM THROUGH THE SPIRIT; FOR THE SPIRIT SEARCHES ALL THINGS, EVEN THE DEPTHS OF GOD.

I CORINTHIANS 2:14 BUT A NATURAL MAN DOES NOT ACCEPT THE THINGS OF THE SPIRIT OF GOD, for they are foolishness to him; and HE CANNOT UNDERSTAND THEM, BECAUSE THEY ARE SPIRITUALLY APPRAISED.

HABAKKUK 3:3-4 His splendor covers the heavens, And the earth is full of His praise. His radiance is like the sunlight; He has rays flashing from His hand, And THERE IS THE HIDING OF HIS POWER.

JOHN 7:17 IF ANYONE IS WILLING TO DO HIS WILL, HE WILL KNOW OF THE TEACHING, whether it is of God or whether I speak from Myself.

JOHN 13:4-11 Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come forth from God and was going back to God, got up from supper, and laid aside His garments; and taking a towel, He girded Himself. Then He poured water into the basin, and began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded. So He came to Simon Peter. He said to Him, "Lord, do You wash my feet?" Jesus answered and said to him, "What I do you do not realize now, but you will understand hereafter." Peter said to Him, "Never shall You wash my feet!" Jesus answered him, "If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me." Simon Peter said to Him, "Lord, then wash not only my feet, but also my hands and my head." Jesus said to him, "He who has bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you." For He knew the one who was betraying Him; for this reason He said, "Not all of you are clean."

LUKE 22:11-12 And you shall say to the owner of the house, 'The Teacher says to you, "Where is the guest room in which I may eat the Passover with My disciples?"' And HE WILL SHOW YOU A LARGE, FURNISHED UPPER ROOM; PREPARE IT THERE."

LUKE 22:23-24 And they began to discuss among themselves which one of them it might be who was going to do this thing. And THERE AROSE ALSO A DISPUTE AMONG THEM AS TO WHICH ONE OF THEM WAS REGARDED TO BE GREATEST.

JOHN 13:4-5 GOT UP FROM SUPPER, AND LAID ASIDE HIS GARMENTS; AND TAKING A TOWEL, HE GIRDED HIMSELF. THEN HE POURED WATER INTO THE BASIN, AND BEGAN TO WASH THE DISCIPLES' FEET AND TO WIPE THEM WITH THE TOWEL WITH WHICH HE WAS GIRDED

JOHN 13:14-16 If I then, the Lord and the Teacher, washed your feet, YOU ALSO OUGHT TO WASH ONE ANOTHER'S FEET. FOR I GAVE YOU AN EXAMPLE THAT YOU ALSO SHOULD DO AS I DID TO YOU. Truly, truly, I say to you, a slave is not greater than his master, nor is one who is sent greater than the one who sent him.

JOHN 13:4 got up from supper, and LAID ASIDE HIS GARMENTS; AND TAKING A TOWEL, HE GIRDED HIMSELF.

JOHN 13:5 Then HE POURED WATER INTO THE BASIN, AND BEGAN TO WASH THE DISCIPLES' FEET AND TO WIPE THEM WITH THE TOWEL WITH WHICH HE WAS GIRDED.

JOHN 13:10 Jesus said to him, "He who has bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and YOU ARE CLEAN, BUT NOT ALL OF YOU."

MATTHEW 6:11-12 GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD. AND FORGIVE US OUR DEBTS, AS WE ALSO HAVE FORGIVEN OUR DEBTORS.

1 JOHN 1:9 IF WE CONFESS OUR SINS, HE IS FAITHFUL AND RIGHTEOUS TO FORGIVE US OUR SINS AND TO CLEANSE US FROM ALL UNRIGHTEOUSNESS.

JOHN 13:11 For He knew the one who was betraying Him; for this reason He said, "Not all of you are clean."

JOHN 13:8(a) Peter said to Him, "NEVER SHALL YOU WASH MY FEET!"

JOHN 13:13 You call Me Teacher and Lord; and YOU ARE RIGHT, FOR SO I AM.

JOHN 13:8 Jesus answered him, "IF I DO NOT WASH YOU, YOU HAVE NO PART WITH ME."

JOHN 13:9-10 Simon Peter said to Him, "Lord, then wash not only my feet, but also my hands and my head." Jesus said to him, "HE WHO HAS BATHED NEEDS ONLY TO WASH HIS FEET, BUT IS COMPLETELY CLEAN; AND YOU ARE CLEAN, BUT NOT ALL OF YOU."

GENESIS 18:3-5 "My Lord, if now I have found favor in Your sight, please do not pass Your servant by. PLEASE LET A LITTLE WATER BE BROUGHT AND WASH YOUR FEET, AND REST YOURSELVES UNDER THE TREE; and I will bring a piece of bread, that you may refresh yourselves; after that you may go on, since you have visited your servant." And they said, "So do, as you have said."

JUDGES 19:20-21 The old man said, "Peace to you. Only let me take care of all your needs; however, do not spend the night in the open square." **SO HE TOOK HIM INTO HIS HOUSE AND GAVE THE DONKEYS FODDER, AND THEY WASHED THEIR FEET AND ATE AND DRANK.**

MATTHEW 10:14 Whoever does not receive you, nor heed your words, as you go out of that house or that city, **SHAKE THE DUST OFF YOUR FEET.**

LUKE 7:44 Turning toward the woman, He said to Simon, "Do you see this woman? I entered your house; **YOU GAVE ME NO WATER FOR MY FEET, BUT SHE HAS WET MY FEET WITH HER TEARS AND WIPED THEM WITH HER HAIR.**

1 TIMOTHY 5:10 having a reputation for good works; and if she has brought up children, if she has shown hospitality to strangers, **IF SHE HAS WASHED THE SAINTS' FEET**, if she has assisted those in distress, and if she has devoted herself to every good work.

MATTHEW 20:28 **JUST AS THE SON OF MAN DID NOT COME TO BE SERVED, BUT TO SERVE, AND TO GIVE HIS LIFE A RANSOM FOR MANY."**

LUKE 12:37 **BLESSED ARE THOSE SLAVES WHOM THE MASTER WILL FIND ON THE ALERT WHEN HE COMES; TRULY I SAY TO YOU, THAT HE WILL GIRD HIMSELF TO SERVE, AND HAVE THEM RECLINE AT THE TABLE, AND WILL COME UP AND WAIT ON THEM.**

JOHN 13:14-15 If I then, the Lord and the Teacher, washed your feet, **YOU ALSO OUGHT TO WASH ONE ANOTHER'S FEET. FOR I GAVE YOU AN EXAMPLE THAT YOU ALSO SHOULD DO AS I DID TO YOU.**

1 CORINTHIANS 16:18 For **THEY HAVE REFRESHED MY SPIRIT AND YOURS.** Therefore acknowledge such men.

2 TIMOTHY 1:16 The Lord grant mercy to the house of Onesiphorus, **FOR HE OFTEN REFRESHED ME** and was not ashamed of my chains

PHILEMON 1:7 For I have come to have much joy and comfort in your love, because **THE HEARTS OF THE SAINTS HAVE BEEN REFRESHED THROUGH YOU, BROTHER.**

ROMANS 15:32 **SO THAT I MAY COME TO YOU IN JOY BY THE WILL OF GOD AND FIND REFRESHING REST IN YOUR COMPANY.**

ACTS 17:24-25 The God who made the world and all things in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands; **NOR IS HE SERVED BY HUMAN HANDS, AS THOUGH HE NEEDED ANYTHING**, since He Himself gives to all people life and breath and all things

PSALM 67:1-2 God be gracious to us and bless us, And cause His face to shine upon us—Selah. That Your way may be known on the earth, Your salvation among all nations.
