

#7 VERSES QUOTED AT BIBLE STUDY SEPTEMBER 13, 2017

PSALM 106:34-36 & 41-45

“They did not destroy the peoples, As the LORD commanded them, ³⁵ But they mingled with the nations And learned their practices, ³⁶ And served their idols, Which became a snare to them.”

“Then He gave them into the hand of the nations, And those who hated them ruled over them. ⁴² Their enemies also oppressed them, And they were subdued under their power. ⁴³ Many times He would deliver them; They, however, were rebellious in their counsel, And *so* sank down in their iniquity. ⁴⁴ Nevertheless He looked upon their distress When He heard their cry; ⁴⁵ And He remembered His covenant for their sake, And relented according to the greatness of His lovingkindness.”

MICAH 7:18

“Who is a God like You, who pardons iniquity And passes over the rebellious act of the remnant of His possession? He does not retain His anger forever, Because He delights in unchanging love.”

JOSHUA 18:3

“Speak to the sons of Israel and say to them, ‘When you cross over the Jordan into the land of Canaan, ⁵² then you shall drive out all the inhabitants of the land from before you, and destroy all their figured stones, and destroy all their molten images and demolish all their high places; ⁵³ and you shall take possession of the land and live in it, for I have given the land to you to possess it.’”

“But the sons of Benjamin did not drive out the Jebusites who lived in Jerusalem”

JUDGES 1:27 (MANASSEH)

“they put the Canaanites to forced labor, but they did not drive them out completely.”

JUDGES 1:29 (EPHRAIM)

“Ephraim did not drive out the Canaanites who were living in Gezer”

JUDGES 1:30 (ZEBULUN)

“Zebulun did not drive out the inhabitants of Kitron”

JUDGES 1:31 (ASHER)

“Asher did not drive out the inhabitants of Acco”

JUDGES 1:33 (NAPHTALI)

“Naphtali did not drive out the inhabitants of Beth-shemesh”

JUDGES 1:34 (DAN)

“Then the Amorites forced the sons of Dan into the hill country, for they did not allow them to come down to the valley”

JUDGES 1:1-2

“Now it came about after the death of Joshua that the sons of Israel inquired of the LORD, saying, “Who shall go up first for us against the Canaanites, to fight against them?”² The LORD said, “Judah shall go up; behold, I have given the land into his hand.”

JUDGES 1:19

“Now the LORD was with Judah, and they took possession of the hill country; but they could not drive out the inhabitants of the valley because they had iron chariots”

JUDGES 1:12

“And Caleb said, “The one who attacks Kiriath-sepher and captures it, I will even give him my daughter Achsah for a wife.”

“They said to him, “Inquire of God, please, that we may know whether our way on which we are going will be prosperous.”⁶ The priest said to them, “Go in peace; your way in which you are going has the LORD’s approval.”

JUDGES 18:7

“Then the five men departed and came to Laish and saw the people who were in it living in security, after the manner of the Sidonians, quiet and secure; for there was no ruler humiliating *them* for anything in the land, and they were far from the Sidonians and had no dealings with anyone.”

JUDGES 18:8-9

“When they came back to their brothers at Zorah and Eshtaol, their brothers said to them, “What *do you report?*”⁹ They said, “Arise, and let us go up against them; for we have seen the land, and behold, it is very good. And will you sit still? Do not delay to go, to enter, to possess the land.”

JUDGES 18:16

“The six hundred men armed with their weapons of war, who were of the sons of Dan, stood by the entrance of the gate.”

JUDGES 18:27-29

“Then they took what Micah had made and the priest who had belonged to him, and came to Laish, to a people quiet and secure, and struck them with the edge of the sword; and they burned the city with fire.²⁸ And there was no one to deliver *them*, because it was far from Sidon and they had no dealings with anyone, and it was in the valley which is near Beth-rehob. And they rebuilt the city and lived in it.²⁹ They called the name of the city Dan, after the name of Dan their father who was born in Israel; however, the name of the city formerly was Laish.”

DEUTERONOMY 9:5-6
